2022 NAPLAN

Term 2 commencing Tuesday 10 May. The tests are in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. An Information Sheet will be emailed to parents who have students in Years 3 or 5 in the near future. As a lead-up to NAPLAN the students will undertake a practice test on over the coming weeks.
