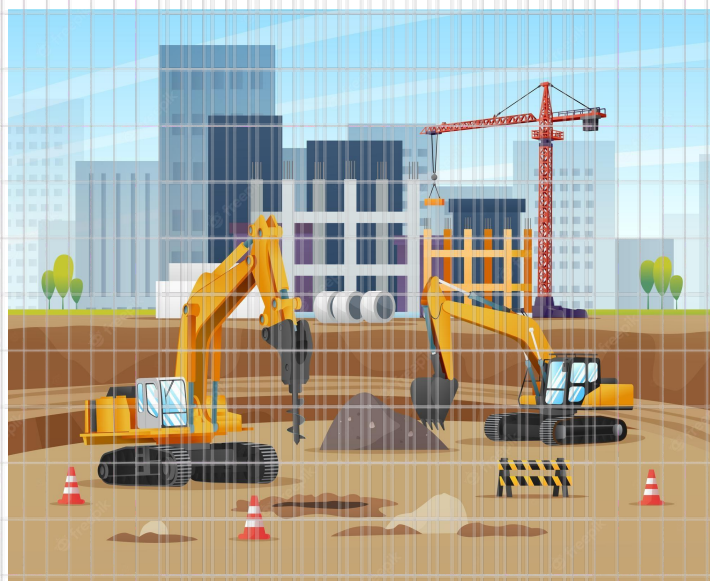


# My school is changing!

I can also wear headphones in the playground if I like. I can bring these in from home to wear at school.

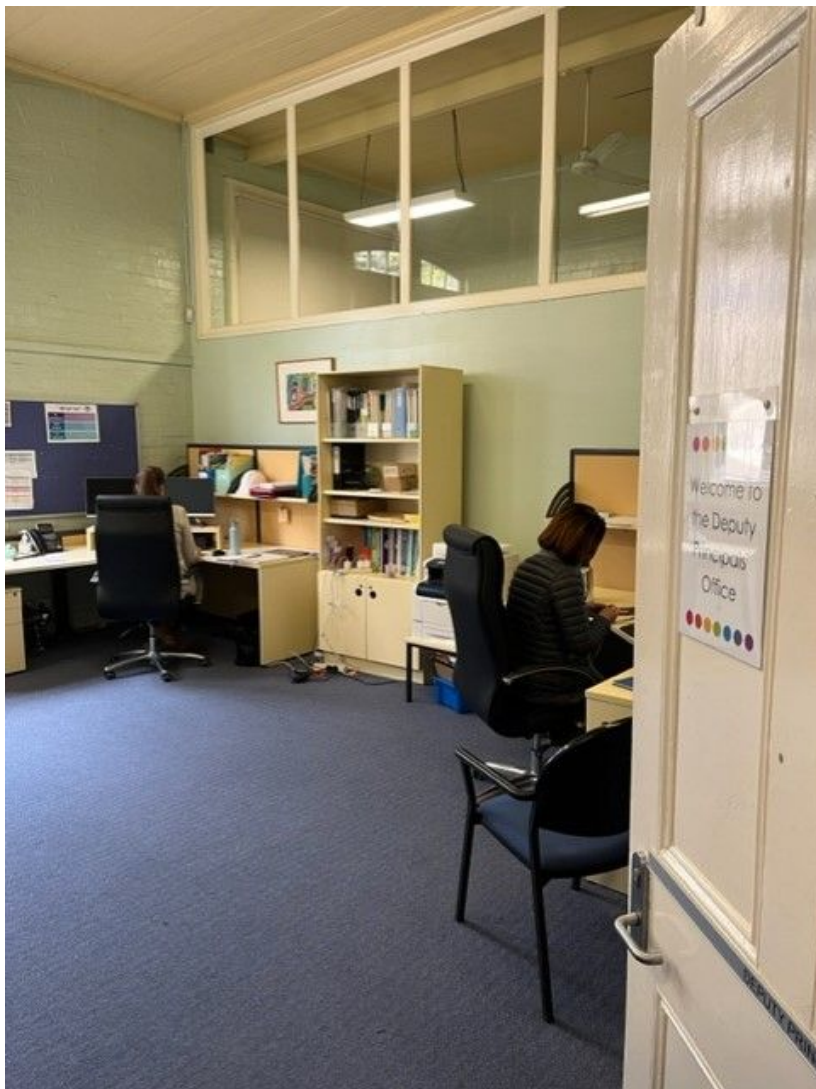
The playground is going to look different. There will be areas that I can no longer play in, but there will also be new areas to play and things to play with, like board games, drawing and building blocks.
