• School Plan 2021 – 2024

I would like to share some of our work that has been going on in teaching and learning. WE have discovered that our measurement data is down compared to Similar Schools. WE have undertaken a process with our staff to find out why this is the case. We have come up with four recommendations:

- 1. more hands on measurement activities
- 2. better understanding of problem solving eg. how long is the paper clip
- 3. better understanding of mathematical language eg. perimeter and area
- 4. better flow of mathematical operations before undertaking measurement

TREASURER'S REPORT

Fundraising from 1 October, fundraising team has generated around 4K profit Example includes:

• Halloween 2020 event: 3K (net profit)

Animal calendar: 0.7K (at this moment)

• Celebratory bucket in October: 0.7K

• Sponsorship receipt: 1.2K (Neutral Bay School of Dance and Timbertime Toys!)

Canteen and Uniformshop's revenue/profit level is back to pre COVID level. October result:

Canteen cost does not include payroll cost. Although we are still receiving the jobkeeper.

Therefore, we can retain the entire gross profit into our reserve.

Please note we are receiving JobKeeper payment from ATO until December 2020. We may not be eligible to receive JobKeeper after January 2021 since our revenue is getting back to pre-COVID level.

Band - Membership Fee refund

Thank you for those who paid the membership fee in February/March.

For those who paid the membership fee in Senior/Concert band, we are offering the refund since some band activities did not take place. 48 members are impacted on the refund.

Now, we have the bank account detail for 40 members.
