			Using a deep fryer, do not overcrowd the frying basket. To prevent splattering oil or burning yourself, do not touch the frying basket or add food while the basket is submerged in oil. It is important never to leave your fryer unattended. Hazard if cooked only a few minutes too long.  In the event of oil fire, never use water to put out the fire. A Wet Chemical extinguisher or covering the fryer with a metal lid is the best way to put out an fire. Call 000 immediately if an oil fire occurs.  A fire blanket on hand as well as a Wet Chemical extinguisher.

Cooking			*Water is a very dangerous liquid when deep frying. When water encounters very hot oil (about 180 °C) water vaporizes instantaneously turning into super heated steam. It expands quickly, which can cause oil to splatter and risk bodily injury. Do not let water get into the hot oil or use water to cool, or clean the appliance while food is deep-frying.
