Entry to Senior Chamber Policy

The Senior Chamber at Neutral Bay Public School (School) is a group of advanced students within the School Orchestra. A student in the School Orchestra who has demonstrated a number of, or a combination of the following shall be offered a position within the Senior Chamber:

1. who is in Year 5 or Year 6 currently at the School and who has demonstrated a high level of music reading and the ability in playing an instrument within the Orchestra;
2. who is at Grade 4 AMEB or Book 4 Suzuki or higher, or failing that, it will be at the discretion to the Orchestra conductor to offer a position, but in any case, no lower than Grade 3 AMEB or Book 3 Suzuki;
3. who has demonstrated to be an exceptional musician and is talented in musical skills and is able to play advanced music with ease and little supervision within the Orchestra;
4. who has demonstrated a maturity level to be able to participate with little supervision, takes direction and shows good behavior within the Orchestra and must satisfy numbers 2 and 3 above;
5. who must continue to participate in the School Orchestra while being a member of the Senior Chamber;

The decision of the Orchestra conductor to offer or not to offer a position to a student is final. The decision is to be made by the Orchestra conductor alone, independent from parents. A position may be offered at any time during the School year.
