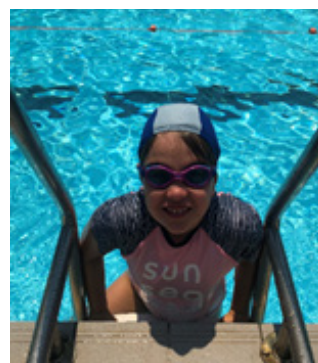

Nearly New Uniform Shop

Neutral Bay Public School greatly appreciates the generosity of parents who donated quality pre-loved uniforms. The response from the community has been incredible and resulted in donations and cash sales of \$6,898 to date. About 200 families have used the Nearly New shop with over 1,100 items sold. We estimate that the initiative found a new home for 110 kilograms of clothing. According to Rag Trader, Australians discard 23 kilograms of clothing per capita every year and this results in six tonnes of textiles and clothing contributed to landfills in Australia every 10 minutes.

Donations of good quality, clean items of unused uniforms are always welcome (we do not accept hats or tights). Please leave donations in the large uniform shop box to the right of the window in the main school office. Your support will ensure that we can continue to collect and redistribute school uniforms to give back to the school and students, while making a positive difference.
