#### More data to share with you

Last week in the newsletter, I presented some data from the Tell Them From Me survey. Here is another interesting piece of data from the student survey. Our students from Years 4 - 6 (361 students) were asked 'What do you do when you feel stuck on a challenging problem or concept in Mathematics?'. These were their responses.

- 67 students Ask a peer for help
- 87 students Ask a teacher for help
- 65 students Persevere in trying to solve the problem
- 27 students Erase my work and start again
- 74 students Reread the problem
- 37 students Take a break and revisit the problem later 4 students Give up

What might be the implications for your child's learning? You may like to ask your child this question.
