NAIDOC WEEK CELEBRATIONS

NAIDOC Week is from 3-10 July 2022 and is a time we celebrate First Nations cultures and recognise the achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. NAIDOC Week is an opportunity for all Australians to learn about First Nations cultures and participate in celebration of the oldest, continuous living cultures on earth. Here are some things you can do to achieve this with your family in the school holidays.

The Gai-mariagal Festival

The Gai-mariagal Festival aims to raise awareness of First Nations People living in the Northern Sydney region. The festival starts on Sorry Day (26 May) and goes through to the end of NAIDOC Week each year.

This year, the festival's theme is 'Nalawala Ngara' sit down and listen – and invites us to commemorate and celebrate together. <u>Barangaroo</u>

The Barangaroo harbourside precinct is named after a powerful Cammeraygal leader of the Eora Nation at the time of European colonisation. Barangaroo was a key figure in local Aboriginal culture and community and is remembered through the generations as a defender of her culture and traditions. Barangaroo is hosting a variety of events in the school holidays in line with NAIDOC week, such as:

- A NAIDOC Up Late Concert on Saturday 2 June from 7pm-11pm
- Aboriginal dance workshops for children aged 5-13 years from Monday 4 July – Thursday 7 July. These workshops are led by Jannawi Dance Club and include a cultural clap stick dance, traditional footstep techniques, two traditional songs in Darug language and the accompanying dances to the songs.
- Cultural tours of the native history of Sydney Harbour, the importance of the land to Aboriginal heritage and its significance to the clans of the Eora nation that lived where Sydney now stands.
